TKT gives teachers a strong foundation in the core areas of teaching knowledge needed in the English language teaching classroom

There are no formal entry requirements. However, anyone wishing to take TKT is strongly advised to have at least an intermediate level of English — Level B1 of the Council of Europe's Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)

TKT has three core modules. These can be taken together in one exam session, over three sessions. Each module consists of a test of 80 objective questions, lasting 80 minutes, which require you to select the correct answer and mark this on a computerised answer sheet.

The minimum entry requirement is 10 candidate entries for each exam session
